
Business Support for Monon/86th Project

The intersection crossing of the Monon Trail at 86th Street is one of the most dangerous pedestrian and bicyclist crossings in the city of Indianapolis, as noted by numerous crashes and injuries. This intersection is not just any crossroad; it's a bustling hub where more than one million trail users annually and an average of 35,000 vehicles daily converge.

Concerned community organizations and individuals are working toward a temporary Tactical Urbanism project at the Monon & 86th St. to improve safety for trail users crossing 86th St and accessing the Monon Trail from 86th St. sidewalks. We currently are working on a project to improve the intersection temporarily. We have a grant from the Indiana State Department of Health and CIBA Foundation for the project and are working with the City of Indianapolis Department of Public Works for approval of Tactical Urbanism and Art in the Right of Way permits. Estimated timeframe of project: April - October 2024.



We're asking the following:
